The Recipient on Both Sides

Section 504 and the two harms only a university can produce with a license plate camera

A city that photographs a license plate has a photograph. A university has the parking office that can turn that photograph into a student's name, and it runs the counseling center too.

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American colleges and universities are on the network.

Not a campus camera system. A national one, with more than 83,000 cameras. A police department in one state can search the cameras at a college in another, and the college may have no working idea who searched or why.

Records from only eight of these schools held information on 42,392,471 searches.

WHAT HAS BEEN WRITTEN, AND WHAT HAS NOT

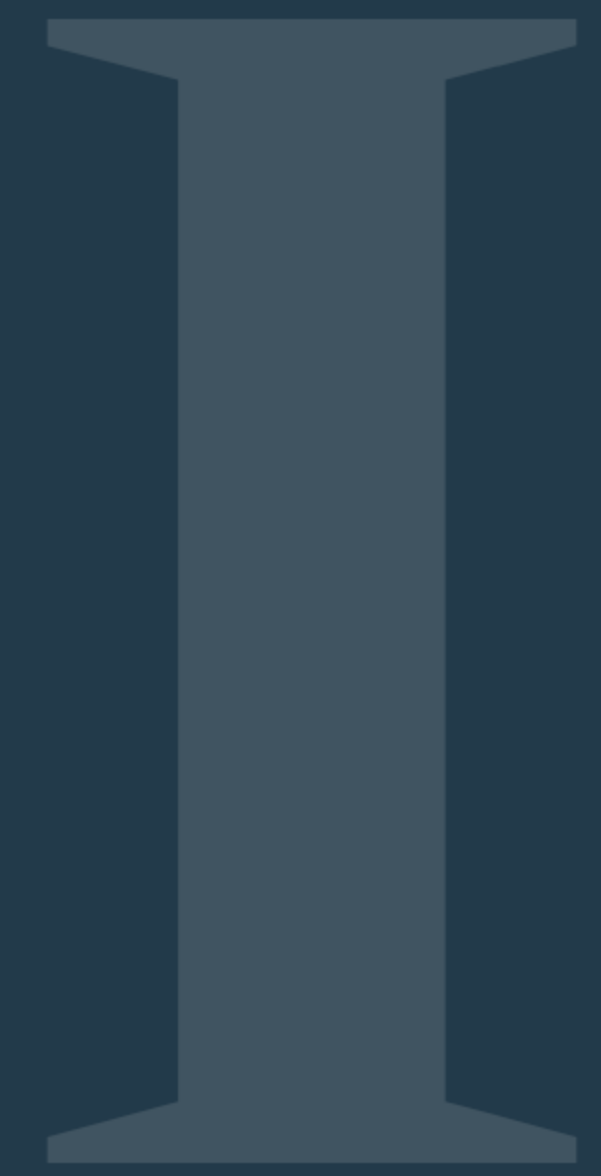
The coverage so far is about immigration, protest, and abortion. This is about disability, and it is the version these schools cannot argue their way out of.

Harm one

The government prints a disability symbol on the license plate. The camera photographs plates. The university holds the parking records that turn a plate into a person. Put those three together and a disability record exists that nobody decided to create.

Harm two

The same university runs the counseling center that treats students who believe they are being watched, and the camera network that makes them right. In a city those are two different institutions. Here they are one.



The Deployment

What was built, who bought it, and why a campus is not a city

The facts are not in dispute and were not gathered by the author. They come from public records requests, the network's own audit logs, and the vendor's own published materials.



The Register Nobody Built

First harm: the government prints the credential where the camera looks, and the school holds the key

This harm needs no clinical evidence and no disputed camera capability. It needs a plate, a lookup table, and one institution holding both.

The Recipient on Both Sides

Second harm: the school runs the treatment and removes the thing the treatment needs

A city cannot produce this harm, because in a city the camera operator and the clinician work for different institutions.
